Take I-5 to exit #233 for Albany. Turn east (toward Lebanon) at the light at the top of the ramp (highway 20). About 8 miles on take Highway 226 to the left. Follow 226 into Scio then turn right (following 226) just past the Car Quest auto parts store and before you cross the bridge. Go 1.1 miles then turn right onto Franklin Butte Rd. Event field entrance is about 500 yards on the right.
